

# INSTRUCTIONS OPERATORS



- Follow the instructions of the driver. The driver is the supervisor, follow these instructions and ask the driver when you have any questions.
- Only people who have read and heard the instructions are allowed to collect paper.
- Before starting the route, make sure agreements are made on who does what.
- Make sure everyone is aware when the installation is being turned on.
- Only 1 person is allowed to operate the installation.
- If you are not operating the installation, keep your distance and know where the emergency stop is.
- For every single truck step: only 1 volunteer is allowed to drive standing up on the step (for short displacements). The rest need to walk or join the driver in the cabin.
- Strictly forbidden: sitting ON or IN the waste opening.
- Don't grab paper, a container or any moving objects in the flatbed.
- Watch out for containers that are being lifted or are swinging back.
- Only 1 break of 15 minutes is acceptable per route for coffee, tea or drinks.
- If you bring your own clothes (e.g. raincoat) and you are not wearing it, you need to keep this in the driver's cabin.
- Correct each other when you see anything unsafe.
- Make sure everyone stays at a safe distance from the truck.
- There will not be any paper collected outside of the collection area.
- Collecting paper that is business related is prohibited. In case a business property is combined with a home, max 1m<sup>3</sup> paper per connection is tolerated.
- Avoid driving in rear (high damage risk). If you do drive in rear: all volunteers need to stand next to the truck (never behind), and follow the driver's instructions.
- When instructions are not being followed, the driver can decide to not start the route or end the route and return immediately.
